TKO₂ First Long-Term Penetrating Industrial Lubricant

St. Charles, MO -- Findett Corporation (www.findett.com) has introduced and is now shipping TKO₂, a new general-maintenance lubricant for industrial applications involving ferrous metals. The proprietary formula of this spray-on penetrating lubricant displaces corrosion products such as rust and puts down a long-lasting barrier film that keeps water out and prevents further corrosion.

Until now, the usefulness of penetrating lubricants was limited by their tendency to evaporate rapidly without providing long-term lubrication and protection. To meet industrial requirements, TKO₂ incorporates a long-lifetime formulation. Once applied to a metal surface, it remains in place and remains active.

Early results with TKO₂ on bolts, valves, hinges, bushings and other parts show that TKO₂ "knocks out" existing rust and corrosion in a few minutes. After the initial application, free movement is maintained indefinitely because the lubricant does not evaporate quickly. It has also proven to be of value in coating tools prior to long-term storage.

For ease of use, TKO₂ is packaged in 16-oz. spray cans that contain the active components, a carrier solvent and a non-flammable propellant. Because of its long-lifetime formulation, it reduces the frequency of countless routine maintenance tasks.
